YARN BOMBING

Yarn bombing is a type of graffiti or street art. It uses colorful blends of knitted, weaving or crocheted pieces. Yarn bombers seek to reclaim a degraded area or create a unique coexistence with nature. It is also called yarn storm, warrior knitting, kniffiti, urban knitting or graffiti knitting.

CONCEPT

Contemporary masked theatre, movement and music.

A stroll, a procession of colours, punctuated by moments of interaction with the public and the environment.

If you wish, a yarn bombing workshop can be organized in parallel.

Participants will be able to learn the sacred art of giant knitting, using their arms and recycled materials to create a colorful art installation (open to children, adults, and families of all ages).
